The Role of the Associate in Arts Degree in
University Transfer.



AA and AS Degrees and General Education- 60 credit hours

- ▶ AA – 36 hours of general education, 24 hours for prerequisite/university transfer requirements.
- ▶ AS – 15 hours of general education, 45 + hours of technical, career specific training, not typically transferrable to a University.
- ▶ General Education – the general courses all students must take. Required math, English, etc. General education courses are liberal arts courses rather than business or technical courses. The State requires that certain courses be part of general education throughout the state.



SF College AA General Education Courses

- **Communications, *minimum 6 hours, 2 courses***
- **Research and Analysis, *minimum 3 hours, 1 course***
- **Humanities, *Minimum 6 hours, 2 courses***
- **Multicultural and Global Awareness, *minimum 2 hours, 1 course***
- **Social Sciences, *minimum 6 hours, 2 courses***
- **Natural Sciences, *minimum 7 hours, 2 courses***
- **Mathematics, *minimum 6 hours, 2 courses***

Santa Fe helps students be sure they have all of the courses required for their intended transfer at their intended institution.

Mathematics

6 HRS (6 hrs from A) OR (3 hrs from A & 3 hrs from B)

Note: Mathematics courses require a grade of C or higher.

We strongly recommend CLM placement test (G-25) to determine proper math placement. MGF1100 or MAT1033 (elective credit) is a prerequisite for MGF1106 and MGF1107. MAT1033 or MAT1032 and MAT1034 (elective credit) is a prerequisite for MAC1105.

You need 6 hours of math beyond MAT1033 or MGF 1100. Be aware, Math courses require a C or higher.

Be sure to check for transfer courses.

If your transfer major doesn't have a specific math requirement, you can take MGF1107 and MGF1106 to fulfill the 6 hours of math
 • You only need a D in MAT1033 to take these two classes

Transfer Requirements

UNF - Requires ACG2001-ACG2011 (or ACG2021). College of Business with majors in Economics, Finance, Financial Services, International Business, Management, Marketing, and Transportation and Logistics.

USF - Requires ACG2001-ACG2011 (or ACG2021). College of Business with degrees in Economics, Finance, Management and Organization, MIS, Marketing, General Business, and International Business.

UWF - Requires ACG2001-ACG2011 (or ACG2021). College of Business with degrees in Economics, Finance, General Business, Management, MIS, and Marketing.

The State of Florida encourages students to complete an AA prior to University Transfer

- Guaranteed admission to a State University System (SUS) University. 12 Universities, UF and FSU are the preeminent universities. Upwards of 60% of SF students who apply to UF are accepted. 2,219 students for fall 2015.

Guaranteed transfer of general education core courses. Every FCS and SUS institution **MUST** award general education credit for specific general education courses that the state requires. If a student completes all 36 hours on general education and transfers prior to graduation, they must be given credit for 36 hours of general education whether or not the transfer institution recognizes the course within their own general education.



Santa Fe College has several articulation agreements in place to further assist our students as they transfer to partner Universities.

- ▶ SF 2 UF – Bridges to Baccalaureate. NIH funded, nontraditional bio-behavioral students, intended to encourage post graduate study.
- ▶ Geopaths – NSF funded intended to encourage transfer in geological and earth sciences.
- ▶ Gator Engineering
- ▶ Gator Construction and Design-UF selects students and promises admission to those who complete certain requirements here. SF to UNF
- ▶ SF to FAMU – guaranteed admission for successful SF graduates
- ▶ SF2UNF - SF graduates who meet requirements are guaranteed admission in building construction and management, sports management, Business, various social and behavioral science majors, computing and engineering.
